Social Distancing	Only partake if numbers on or around the green are limited to 30 and 2 metre social distancing is observed. (1 Metre plus mitigation, e.g. face masks worn)	Competition Administrator	Immediate	All Bowlers

Over 70's	This group have additional risks due to the nature of the virus. 2 metre rule should be strictly adhered to and it is preferable masks should be worn	Competition Administrator	immediate	All Bowlers
Opening of buildings	The club has been open since 4 th July and has its own risk assessment and social distancing regime.	Club Committee	4 th July	All Attendees
